PROVIDER COURSES – MILESTONES - July 1, 2006

Starting on **July 1, 2006**, **all AHA courses** are to be taught using the new science (2005 AHA Guidelines), as per the ***Revised Core Instructor Course Policy Training Memo*** dated May 4, 2006.

HEARTSAVER PRODUCTS RELEASED MAY 31st

The Heartsaver and Family & Friends product line, including manuals, videos and posters, is now available for purchase from all ECC Material Distributors. Announcements for all these products were sent last month and *are also located on the **Instructor Network** under the “AHA Courses” column.*

Reminder: As announced at Guidelines rollouts, the 2006 Heartsaver courses introduce the concept of competency tests. These formal skill tests are done during designated testing lessons in each of the Heartsaver courses. The skills testing checklists are located on the HS Instructor CD and attached in this newsletter.

In Heartsaver courses that include CPR and AED modules only, there are no written tests. For Heartsaver First Aid and Heartsaver Pediatric First Aid, there are a series of short written tests included in the student workbook.

The new testing model is discussed on pages 17 and 18 of the new ***Heartsaver Instructor Manual***, with additional information in the “Course-Specific details” section for each course.

*****NOTE**:*** *You should not be utilizing the Heartsaver Bridge Exams as a testing tool for Heartsaver courses.*

NO AUDIO (SOUND) ON HEARTSAVER STUDENT CD ROMs

The Heartsaver Student CD ROM does not have a voice over for the video and therefore the CDs have no sound. This was done intentionally and is not a product malfunction or error. ECC's Product Development Dept. made the decision to use subtitles rather than audio for the video clips.

REVISED CORE INSTRUCTOR COURSE TRAINING MEMO

TC Coordinators and Regional Faculty were emailed the revised Core Instructor Course Training Memo in May. The revised memo states that the AHA Core Instructor Course will be used to train all new instructors after October 1, 2006. Current Instructors are no longer required to complete the Core Instructor Course unless they fall into one of the following categories:

- ♥ Are adding a discipline (i.e. a BLS Instructor adding ACLS Instructor status)
- ♥ Are identified as having documented deficiencies in either skills or required knowledge of course curricula
- ♥ Are a current National Faculty, Regional Faculty or Training Center Faculty member
- ♥ Are being appointed to Training Center Faculty

National Faculty, Regional Faculty and Training Center Faculty must complete the Core Instructor Course before they can teach that course or the discipline specific module of the new Instructor course but no later than June 30, 2007.

While the requirement that all Instructors must go through the Core Instructor Course has been lifted, a TC Coordinator could choose to require that all Instructors aligned with their TC complete the course. The Core Instructor Course is a valuable tool for all instructors—both current and new. It will be an excellent way to strengthen current Instructors skills and help improve the delivery of AHA science education during AHA courses. This revised Training Memo as well as all other memos is posted on the ***Instructor Network under the “My Instructor Information” tab.***

INSTRUCTOR NETWORK PORTAL - TC Coordinators check this site often

TC Coordinators, please check the Instructor Network Portal on a weekly basis to see if any of your Instructors have registered and are pending your approval. You may receive emailed notification from the Service Center that instructor registrations are pending, but we also encourage you to be pro-active in checking the Instructor Network Portal regularly.

These templates can be used for the newly released Course Cards as well.
